250 HOURS OF ADORATION

At the end of each month there is formal adoration. Each person who attends counts towards 250 hours.

Personal adoration can happen at any time. The church is open daily from 7:00 am to 6:00 pm.

During Holy Week, March 29,2026 through April 4,2026 it is a great time to spend with Jesus.

WHERE TO RECORD YOUR ADORATION HOURS

In the gathering space, there will be a cork board, push pins, cards, and pencils.

Record your hours and what kind of adoration you chose, formal or personal. Pin the card to the cork board.

250 HOURS OF WORKS OF MERCY

All Ministry groups do Works of Mercy. Keep track of the hours, remember each individual counts as an hour. (Example: 6 people clean church it takes 2 hours, $6 \times 2 = 12$ hours.)

Whenever as a parish we donate items that count as Works of Mercy. Record how long it took to write cards or purchase items.

Personal Works of Mercy count as any time you help someone. (Example: take someone to appointment, call someone who is homebound or ill, any action where you are helping someone counts)

Many parishioners are members of organizations who serve others. Those hours count.

WHERE DO YOU RECORD YOUR WORKS OF MERCY? USE THE SAME METHOD THAT YOU USED TO RECORD HOURS OF ADORATION.
