Items required:

Your child will need these items each day he/she is in attendance.

- Backpack: big enough to hold a 9 x 12 piece of paper, a folder & lunchbox,
- Lunch box: *see handbook for lunch requirements.
 - o Packed Lunch Daily (may contain heat-up/microwavable items)
 - o Ice/cold pack
 - FULL Day students: 2 snacks AM/PM
 - o HALF Day students: 1 snack AM
- Water bottle (will be sent home daily to be washed)
- Sturdy shoes, gym shoes, or secure sandals that strap to the foot (please NO FLIP FLOPS)
- Extra clothing- to be kept at school
 - o 2 shirts
 - o 2 pairs pants/shorts
 - 4 pair underwear
 - o 2 pair socks
- Sunscreen (check expiration dates)-to be kept at school
- Rest time bedding, if your child is FULL Day:

NOTE: Bedding is sent home weekly to be laundered. Bedding should be in a REUSABLE shopping bag separate from back packs. Please NO PLASTIC bags!!

- o Bottom sheet/blanket (crib sheet fits best) and top sheet/blanket OR sleeping bag/nap sack
- o Small pillow
