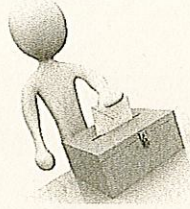

The Parish Pastoral Council is an invaluable advisory body of St. Boniface parishioners who assist the pastor in furthering our parish's mission in a variety of ways. Members of the council chair the task forces who spearhead our efforts to achieve key steps of our Parish Pastoral Plan. The council monitors the financial resources of the parish as well as the condition and maintenance of our physical property. Last but not least, the council advises the pastor on matters important to the wellbeing of the parish.

The by-laws of the Pastoral Council call for regular elections of council members. This year, one elected spot is open for a three-year term. We will accept nominations for the election through October 27, 2024. Any confirmed, registered parishioner may nominate any confirmed, registered parishioner in good standing, including him or herself. Interested nominees must submit to the parish office a short personal biography (no more than two paragraphs) with the following information:

- First and last name
- Personal history at the parish (when you became a parishioner, parish groups of which you are or have been a part, parish activities in which you have participated or chaired)
- Gifts, talents, abilities you bring that would enhance the Pastoral Council

These biographies will be published in the bulletin the weekend of November 9-10, 2024, and the election will be held the weekend of November 16-17, 2024.
