This concludes the raffle portion of this year's fund raiser. The next portion of these funds (\$750+ a \$250 gift card +\$58 residual from the Trail of Treats candy purchases) from the Lutheran Thrivent program (distributed Saturday, 10-26-24) will be used to purchase OTC Health and Beauty aids from the Waterford Pharmacy to be given with the St. Boniface Food Pantry distribution in December. The next portion of funds raised, \$3,000, will be divided into \$1,000 scholarships each given to 3 high school seniors from the Wattsburg Area School District with applications available in April, 2025, to be selected at our May 7, 2025 meeting. The final amount of the monies collected are used to supply Students of the Month plaques for selected Seneca HS seniors along with a dinner in June for the Students of the Months and scholarship winners and their families as well as other community needs. Fabins Trailers generously donated their winning money of \$250 back to the Lions for any needs the Lions' decide to share it with! This directly offsets the one ticket not sold (99 of 100 were sold!) plus extra! Please support their business when a need arises! Others in the past have unselfishly repurposed their winnings to our Club.

With the past help of the St. Boniface Ushers Club (\$26,000) and our 17 raffles, (nearly \$170,000 collected), the Lutheran Thrivent Action Teams (\$1,000), this project has grossed nearly \$197,000! Of these funds, \$85,000 has been returned to the winning ticket holders, 78 students will have received \$78,000 in \$1,000 scholarships as of this spring, and the St. Boniface Food Pantry will have received about \$32,000!
